

### ITINERARY

### Day 1 Invercargill - Cambridge (Tue 15 Jun)

Included is a transfer from Auckland Airport to Cambridge (Flights not included). We travel over the Bombay Hills and into the fertile Waikato Basin where we enjoy a sightseeing tour of Hamilton City. We then continue to the picture-perfect town of Cambridge, situated only 18km from the Mystery Creek Event Centre, and characterized by quaint charm, heritage buildings, and tree-lined streets. Tonight, we enjoy a special Welcome Dinner (D) Hidden Lake Apartments Cambridge- 4 nights

#### Day 2 Mystery Creek Fieldays (Wed 16 Jun)

All day entrance and return transfers from Cambridge are included today to Day One of the Southern Hemisphere's largest agricultural event with over 130,000 visitors and 1000 exhibitors, Fieldays presents New Zealand's agricultural and primary sectors with an international marketplace to advance agriculture, while honouring their three pillars – innovation, education, globalisation (B, D)

### Day 3 Mystery Creek Fieldays (Thu 17 Jun)

All day entrance and return transfers from Cambridge are included for Day Two of the Fieldays (B, D)

## Day 4 Mystery Creek Field days / Waikato excursion & farm visit (Fri 18 Jun)

Morning entrance to the Fieldays is included, or alternatively you might like a free morning for exploring and shopping in downtown Cambridge. This afternoon we enjoy an excursion into the Waikato countryside, and a visit to a local farm (B, D)

### Day 5 Cambridge - Tauranga (Sat 19 Jun)

We travel east today visiting a dairy farm, then climb the Kaimai Ranges and continue to the lovely Bay of Plenty city of Tauranga for our two-night stay. On arrival in Tauranga we visit the Zespri Head Office. Dinner this evening in our hotel restaurant which has wonderful water views (B, D) *Trinity Wharf*, *Tauranga* – 2 *nights* 

### Day 6 Tauranga (Sun 20 Jun)

Today we enjoy a sightseeing tour of central Tauranga, then head over to the beautiful nearby Mount Manganui whose main beach has been crowned 'The Best Beach in New Zealand'. The Mount is a great place to stroll, shop, and people watch from an outside table at any number of the beachside cafes and restaurants. Time at leisure to relax or explore The Mount independently this afternoon, and dinner this evening at a local Tauranga restaurant (B,D)



### Day 7 Tauranga - Whitianga (Mon 21 Jun)

Today we journey north, visiting a local farm, skirting Tauranga Harbour, and travelling through the small town of Katikati before reaching the historic gold mining town of Waihi at the bottom of the Coromandel Peninsula. Continuing north we pass the popular beach towns of Whiritoa, Whangamata, and Tairua before we arrive into the lovely Coromandel beachside holiday town of Whitianga, situated in the stunning unspoilt playground of Mercury Bay which is home of the nearby world renowned Cathedral Cove and Hot Water Beach (B, D) Beachside Resort Whitianga – 2 nights

### Day 8 Whitianga (Tue 22 Jun)

This morning we enjoy Whitianga's café scene with breakfast at a local café, then we embark on a fantastic 2-hour-glass bottom boat cruise where we will explore the breath-taking volcanic coastline including the world-famous Cathedral Cove. This afternoon is free to relax and enjoy the beautiful Whitianga township. This evening we enjoy a Farewell Dinner at a marina view award-winning restaurant(B,D)

### Day 9 Whitianga- Auckland- Invercargill (Wed 23Jun)

We end our tour with a drive west across the fertile Hauraki Plains and over the Bombay Hills into Auckland City where we visit the recently opened All Blacks Experience. This state-of-the-Art guided encounter showcases the history of our national team through exceptional innovation and technology. Some free time in downtown Auckland is also included before we transfer to Auckland Airport for your homeward flights (flights your own arrangements) (B)
